

100 College Scholarships for Alabama Students

Important Note: The purpose of this detailed listing is to help you plan your scholarship search throughout the year. Please find information below about scholarships for Alabama students. Some of the deadlines may be from prior years. Scholarship deadlines are cyclical, so even if a deadline has passed, the website will likely be updated for the 2021-22 cycle. Be sure to reach out to the sponsor or check sponsor websites for the most recent details.

SEPTEMBER 2021

- 1. Alabama Student Grant Program is available only to students at an eligible independent Alabama college or university. This is not a need based program. Grant amounts vary from year-to-year based on the availability of funds, but cannot exceed \$1,200 per academic year. The following institutions are the only participants of the Alabama Student Grant Program: Amridge University, Birmingham Southern College, Faulkner University, Huntingdon College, Miles College, Oakwood University, Samford University, Spring Hill College, South University Montgomery, Stillman College, U.S. Sports Academy, and University of Mobile. The deadline to apply is September 15th. Application found here.
- 2. Miss Indian Alabama Competition Scholarship is for \$5,000. Applicants must be a member of a state or federally recognized Indian Tribe, be an Alabama student and resident between the ages of 17 and 23, must be single, and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. The deadline to apply is September 30th. More info. here.

OCTOBER 2021

- **3. Alabama Student Assistance Program** is a need-based, state/federal grant ranging from \$300 to \$5,000 per academic year. Eligible students are undergraduate students who are Alabama residents attending eligible Alabama institutions. Nearly 80 Alabama institutions participate in the program. To apply please submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. This should be filed by October 1st. More info. Here.
- **4. Auburn University Theatre Scholarship Auditions** is a one-year scholarship. This will be given to outstanding students who participate in the competitive on-site auditions and presentations. To be considered, you must be High school seniors who plan to major in Theatre, have a 3.0 GPA, and reside in Alabama. The deadline to apply is October 12th. More details here.
- **5. Wendy's High School Heisman** ranges from \$500 to \$5,000. To be considered, you must be a high school senior with a 3.0 GPA, have participated in at least 1 of 47 sports, and be a leader in school and in the community and serve as a role model. The deadline to apply is October 17th. Apply here.
- 6. The ACT Student Champion Award recognizes one student in each state who is tenacious and persistent, no matter the challenge, and is prepared for life after high school with a goal in mind and plan in place. ACT Student Champions receive a \$500 non-renewable scholarship, certificate, and state-level recognition. To be considered, you must be high school seniors who have overcome challenges and can articulate their education and/or career actions. At a minimum students must have a composite ACT score of 22 on a single test date OR a Gold ACT® WorkKeys® National Career Readiness Certificate®. The deadline to apply is October 31st. Applications can be found here.
- **7. Horatio Alger Alabama Scholarship Program** is for \$8,000. This is given to high school seniors with a grade point average of 2.0 or higher who demonstrate critical financial need and are residents of Alabama. The deadline to apply is October 25th. Read more here.

NOVEMBER 2021

8. Cross & Smith Scholarship will give \$1,000 towards their college education. This is in hopes to ease the burden of college and help with the many expenses that students encounter each semester. High school seniors or current college

- students that plan to pursue a law degree are eligible to apply. The deadline is November 2nd. Read more here.
- 9. "Tagged for Greatness" ScholarshiP is for \$1,000. To be considered, you must be an incoming freshman at a 4-year college or university and possess academic and leadership excellence. You must also be a member of the Alabama Cattlemen's Association or parents/grandparents of the applicant must be current members of the Alabama Cattlemen's Association for the past two consecutive years. The deadline to apply is November 6th. More details here.
- **10.High School Attending 2-Year Scholarship** is for \$500. This is given to a high school senior planning to enroll at a 2-year college. Applicants must exhibit academic and leadership excellence. They must also be a current member of the Alabama Cattlemen's Association or parents/grandparents of the applicant must be current members of the Alabama Cattlemen's Association for the past two consecutive years. The deadline to apply is November 6th. More info. Here.
- 11.Outstanding Junior Cattlemen Scholarship is for \$1,000. Applicants must be a high school senior planning to enroll at a 2- or 4-year school. They must also be a member of the Alabama Junior Cattlemen's Association, involved in junior cattlemen/youth livestock activities; and be a member of the Alabama Cattlemen's Association or parents/grandparents of the applicant must be current members for the past two consecutive years. The deadline to apply is November 6th. Learn more here.
- **12.Martha Davis Service Award** is for \$1,000. Applicants must be high school seniors who exhibit outstanding leadership and community service. The deadline to apply is November 6th. Read more here.
- **13.Ina E. Powell Memorial Scholarship** is for \$1,500. To be eligible, you must be a female high school senior with a 3.0 GPA. You must be enrolled at Auburn University with plans to graduate from the College of Agriculture, College of Forestry and Wildlife Sciences, College of Human Sciences or College of Education. You must also possess academic and leadership excellence and be involved in the cattle industry. The deadline to apply is November 6th. More info.here.
- **14.Alabama Concrete Industries Association Scholarships** funds two scholarships for \$8,000 each annually to promote the state's youth. One scholarship is specifically designed to remember David F. Wright, a bright engineer who was tragically killed in an airplane crash. Undergrad students interested in the masonry trades can apply before November 30th. <u>Scholarship Website here.</u>

15.Mary Alice Beatty Scholarship is valued at \$5,000. It's designed for young ladies between 17 and 25 who are developing their aerospace career through college courses or flight lessons. Preference is given to training at AAB-accredited schools. To be considered, you must legally reside within Alabama, possess a minimum "B" average, share Beatty's passion for aviation, and demonstrate significant financial need. The deadline is November 14th. Read more here.

DECEMBER 2021

- **16.The Alabama Horse Council** awards two \$1,000 scholarships each year to support individual AHC members or their sons and daughters who are pursuing accredited, in-state higher education, including veterinary school, this Fall. Qualified candidates must hold a high school diploma or GED, select majors relevant to the equine industry, attach two reference letters, and write a 500-word essay about how horses shaped their lives. The deadline is December 30th. Learn more here.
- 17. J.L. Bedsole Baccalaureate Scholarship is up to \$6,000 yearly. This is offered to graduating high school seniors in South Alabama's Mobile, Baldwin, Clarke, Monroe, Washington, and Marengo counties. Other qualifications include holding a minimum 2.5 GPA, scoring at least 21 on the ACT, having an EFC below \$9,000, and completing 60+ hours of community service. The deadline to apply is December 31st. More info. here.
- **18.ARRL** Charles Clarke Cordle Memorial Scholarship is for \$1,000. To be considered, you must be a resident of Georgia or Alabama, a high school senior; must be an active, FCC-licensed ham, and have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference will be given to students of electronics, communications, or related fields. The deadline is December 31st. Read more here.
- **19.Kingsley and Kingsley Employment Lawyers Scholarship.** This is a \$1,000 merit-based essay scholarship available to all University of South Alabama students. The deadline for applications is December 31st. <u>More details here.</u>

JANUARY 2022

20.The Alabama Center for Architecture is committed to investing in the future of the architecture profession by granting scholarships to exceptional architecture students from the state of Alabama. The ACFA Scholarship has given more than \$99,000 in scholarship dollars since its creation. To be eligible, applicants must be high school students entering freshman year of an accredited architecture program, college students entering the first year of an accredited architecture program (i.e. transferring from a junior or technical college program, or enrolling in an architecture program commencing after the freshman year), undergraduate and post-graduate students continuing in an accredited B. Arch or M. Arch program, or post-graduate students entering the first year of an accredited M Arch program. The deadline to apply is january 1st. Apply here.

- 21.The Linly Heflin Scholarship awards Alabama women seeking help with their undergraduate degree at four-year accredited Alabama colleges and universities. Scholarships are awarded annually for four years or until graduation, whichever comes first. Applicants must be U.S. citizens, have an ACT of 23, and attend a college/university full-time. Renewable upon a 2.5 GPA. The deadline for applications is January 10th. Learn more here.
- **22."Don't Wait to Reach Your Potential" Scholarship is for \$500.** To be considered, you must be an Alabama high school student. The deadline is January 6th. <u>More details here.</u>
- 23.ASDAR will award two \$1,500 scholarships. To be considered, all applicants must be Alabama residents. Also, only seniors graduating from an accredited high school or home school program are eligible. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited college or university in the State of Alabama, or if the chosen course of study is not offered within the State of Alabama, plan to attend an out-of-state college or university under the Common Market Proviso. The deadline to apply is January 14th. Application found here.
- **24.Coca-Cola First Generation Scholarship Program.** The scholarship provides \$5,000 a year and is renewable for four years. To be considered, applicants must be a first generation student, be an Alabama resident, have a high school GPA of 3.0 or higher, and demonstrate financial need. The deadline to apply is January 15th. Read more here.
- **25. Birdsong Peanuts Scholarship (FFA)** is for \$1,000. To be eligible, applicants must be high school seniors who are residents of Alabama, Florida, or Georgia and a member of FFA pursuing a degree in agriculture or agribusiness. Applicant's family must be a peanut producer. The deadline to apply is january 15th. <u>Learn more here.</u>
- **26.Red Barn Media Group Scholarship** is for \$1,000. This award is open to U.S. high school seniors and undergraduate students who are members of Future Farmers of America and residents of Alabama. Preference is given to an FFA member from one of the following chapters: Springville HS, St. Clair County HS, Ashville

- HS, Moody HS or Ragland HS (St. Clair County). The deadline for submitting applications is January 15th. <u>More details here.</u>
- 27. Annexstad Leaders for Tomorrow Scholarship provides \$5,000 a year for years 1 to 3 and \$10,000 for year 4, provided that recipients maintain a 3.0 GPA. To be eligible, students must be a first generation student, be an Alabama resident, have an ACT score of 27 or higher, demonstrate financial need, and have successfully triumphed over significant personal and/or family hardship. The deadline for submission is January 15th. More info. here.
- **28. The Saban First in Family Scholarships** are awarded to students who are the first in their family to attend college. The scholarship provides \$5,000 a year, renewable for four years, provided that recipients maintain a 3.0 GPA. To apply, applicants must be an Alabama resident and demonstrate financial need. The deadline for submission is January 15th. <u>Learn more here.</u>
- **29.Alfa Foundation Scholarship Program gives** 100 awards of \$1,000. Applicants must be an Alabama high school senior with a 2.75 minimum GPA; must have a current Alabama Farmers Federation Membership issued in his/her name; Alfa Mutual Insurance employees and their dependent children are eligible to apply. The deadline to apply is January 31st. More details here.

FEBRUARY 2022

- **30.The Ever to Conquer Scholarship** is for \$20,000 over four years (\$5,000 per year) for incoming freshmen or \$10,000 over two years (\$5,000 per year) for incoming transfer students. To be eligible, incoming freshmen must have a minimum 3.0 high school GPA and incoming transfer students must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative transfer GPA.Priority consideration will be given to students who qualify for the Federal Pell Grant and to students who are first-generation college students. The deadline for applications is February 1st. Read more here.
- **31.The Alys Robinson Stephens Performing Arts Scholarship** is presented and administered by the University of Alabama at Birmingham for the students pursuing a music career. The High School seniors attending UAB are eligible. The beneficiary of the Scholarship will receive a \$1000 award. The deadline to apply is February 1st. More info. here.
- **32.MREA Scholarship** is for \$1,000. To be eligible, you must be a resident of Mobile County, be a high school graduating senior, have a 3.0 academic high school record and 21+ ACT score or 900 SAT equivalent, must pursue a career as an educator, and have demonstrated volunteer service to their school and community. The deadline to apply is February 4th. More details here.

- 33. Moak & McCartha Scholarship is for \$1,000 each year. It's designed for incoming college freshmen who have a parent employed full-time at any ABA member bank. High school seniors can apply with a paper application and biographical sketch. Recipients are chosen based on academic merit, financial need, personal character, and potential for development. To be eligible, applicant\s must be bona fide residents of Alabama, have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and ACT score of 20, and demonstrate strong leadership skills. The deadline is February 8th. Learn more here.
- **34. Toyota Motor Sales, USA Inc. Scholarship** will be awarded to a high school senior or college student pursuing a four-year degree in agricultural engineering or agricultural science/technology. To be eligible, you must be a resident of Alabama, California, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, Texas or West Virginia. Applicants must have also been active in extracurricular activities and a completion of the financial analysis section is required. The deadline is February 1st. Read more here.
- **35.Airgas Jerry Baker Scholarship.** This \$2,500 scholarship suits welding engineering majors who are attending college in Alabama, Georgia, or Florida. Funding can be renewed over four years for \$10,000 total. To be considered, you must hold a high school diploma or GED equivalent, matriculate full-time in a post-secondary institution, carry an overall GPA of 3.0 in engineering courses, and demonstrate an interest in welding gas distribution. Applications are accepted from AWS members and non-members through February 15th. More details here.
- 36. MAX4Kids Scholarship Foundation gives ten graduating seniors with a \$2,500 non-renewable scholarship to the institution of his or her choice. The applicant must attend a high school in central or east Alabama, be a graduating senior and entering a 4-year institution, junior college or technical school in the fall, and have a cumulative GPA of 3.0/ the deadline to apply is February 19th. Website found here.
- 37. The CollegeCounts Scholarship provides funding assistance to Alabama high school students who demonstrate a financial need and a genuine desire to make a difference. This organization gives awards of \$4,000 for four-year college enrollees and \$2,000 for two-year college enrollees. Applicants must be a high school senior or first-time college freshman beginning in fall of the year the scholarship is awarded, be a U.S. citizen, be an Alabama resident. Must demonstrate financial need and have a minimum GPA of 2.75 and an ACT score of 26 or below. The deadline to apply is February 25th. More details here.
- **38.Alabama Automotive Manufacturers Association Scholarship** pays for all tuition, fees and books for students interested in the automotive manufacturing industry.

Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA. They will be awarded an annual \$3,600 scholarship (split per semester) to pursue a technical education certificate or associate degree to prepare for the field. The deadline to apply is February 25th. Visit here to apply.

39.Alabama Bankers Association Bankers to Leaders Scholarship is for \$2,000. You must be a high school senior; the parent of the applicant must be employed full time at an Alabama Bankers Association member bank; and have a minimum 2.75 GPA. The deadline is February 12th. Read more here.

MARCH 2022

- **40. Haynes Life Flight 2 Memorial Scholarship** is for \$2,000. To be eligible, you must be an Alabama high school senior pursuing a degree in nursing or EMT certification with a minimum 3.0 GPA. The deadline is March 1st. <u>Learn more here.</u>
- **41.Birmingham Promise scholarships** are open to graduating seniors at Birmingham City Schools. If you are a senior who has been enrolled in Birmingham City Schools since the start of this school year, you can apply for this. Whether the destination is a university or a community college, Birmingham Promise clears financial hurdles so students can pursue their goals and succeed in the future. The deadline is March 1st. Read more here.
- **42.The Nancy Julian Distinguished Young Woman Award** honors the memory of Nancy Julian, a very active member of our League and community. The award goes to an outstanding high school senior who has maintained an excellent academic record and has displayed a willingness to serve her school and community through volunteerism and extra-curricular activities. Applications along with supporting documents are due by March 5. Apply here.
- **43.AASOP Scholarship** will award up to four \$1000 scholarships to students pursuing a degree from a college of business or college of education. Scholarships will be given to high school graduates (or to graduating seniors) who desire to pursue a degree from the college of business or a degree in K-12 education at an accredited Alabama school, college or university. The deadline to apply is March 31st. More info. here.
- **44. Alabama Golf Association Scholarship for Women.** This is an opportunity for members of the high school-level girls' golf team, or any young lady with an interest in golf. The deadline is March 4th. <u>Application found here.</u>

- **45.The JSU Alabama Alabama Power Scholarship** is open to Alabama residents who plan to attend Jacksonville State University. Applicants must major in a business-related area. The amount varies and the deadline for applications is March 15th. More info. here.
- 46.Annual Alabama Governor's School offers academically strong Alabama high school juniors an opportunity to participate in a short residential program of stimulating academic and extra-curricular activity. Each participant will take one morning and one afternoon seminar that will focus on challenging and expanding his or her worldview. The courses include, but are not limited to, fine arts, web design, film, urban geography, modern legal systems, research science, business, engineering, and medicine. All courses are small and designed to stimulate interaction with professors and fellow students. In addition, there will be opportunities to meet business, academic, and political leaders from Alabama and beyond. The deadline to apply is March 15th. Learn more here.
- **47.The Hallman Scholarship** is offered to incoming freshmen who have graduated from Guntersville High School. The amount varies and the deadline to apply is March 1st. Read more here.
- **48.The Ronnie Mendheim Memorial Scholarship** is available to graduating seniors of any Dothan County High School. Awards are based on a combination of academic merit and a history of community service. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale and minimum ACT score of 21. The deadline for applications is March 1st. Apply here.
- **49.The Logan Tullis Memorial Scholarship** is for \$1,500. This will be awarded in memory of Logan Tullis to a graduating senior in Coffee County, Alabama. This student must have a 3.0 GPA, confirmed by high school transcripts, provide a minimum of 2 recommendation letters from non-relatives, and submit an essay. The deadline to apply is March 1st. <u>Application found here.</u>
- **50.Kyle Leonard Memorial Scholarshi**p gives two \$1,500 awards to a graduate of Wicksburg High School in Newton, Alabama, and a graduate of any public or private school within Houston County (including Dothan City Schools). Award will be based on academic achievement, school and community involvement. The deadline is March 1st. Apply here.
- 51. Jay Murphy Scholarship is open to graduating seniors from any Montgomery County high school. This is designed to provide financial aid to deserving individuals who have the desire to become teachers who relate well with young people and who can benefit from the financial assistance it offers. Applicants may be entering or continuing college, individuals who are in education and want to upgrade their skills or working individuals who wish to return to college to

- become teachers. Applicants must have a 2.5 GPA. The deadline to apply is March 1st. Read more here.
- **52.Jackson Family Phoenix Fund Scholarship** is open to graduates of any Montgomery County or Lowndes County public high school. This scholarship was designed to encourage students to pursue degrees in math or the physical, biological or agricultural sciences. Students must attend a Historically Black College or University and major in a non-healthcare science (biology, chemistry, physics, agronomy, horticulture, animal sciences, etc.). To be considered, applicants must have a 3.0 GPA and a minimum ACT score of 20 or a minimum SAT score of 1200. The amount varies and the deadline for submission is March 1st. More details here.
- **53.Jamey McAllister Scholarship** offers \$2,000 to a graduate from Slocomb High School in Geneva County, Alabama who plans to attend any accredited higher ed institution (must be a 2 or 4 year college or university and/or technical school). This student must have participated in a minimum of 2 AHSAA sponsored sports at Slocomb High School, while maintaining a minimum 2.5 GPA. The deadline to apply is March 1st. <u>Learn more here.</u>
- **54.Adam Gay Scholarship** is given to any graduating senior/athlete from Northview High School, Dothan High School or Houston Academy. Awards are based on the student's academic record, athletic accomplishments and character. Applicants must have maintained a B average, participated in a sport at his/her high school and demonstrated good character through leadership roles and service to school and community. The deadline to apply is March 1st. More info. here.
- **55. Todd Webb Scholarship** is for \$1,000 and will be awarded annually to a graduate of any high school within the state of Alabama. Students must plan to attend The University of Alabama, studying in the College of Communication and Information Sciences. A focus on Sport Communication is preferred, but not required. A minimum 3.0 GPA and two reference letters are required. The deadline to apply is March 1st. Read more here.
- **56.The Alabama Home Builders Foundation scholarship** helps fund deserving students who are interested in pursuing an education in the residential building trades in the state of Alabama. Applicants must be a resident of Alabama, must be enrolling in, or attending, an accredited college, technical school or university in Alabama, and must be enrolled in a residential construction-related curriculum. The deadline for applications is March 15th. <u>Learn more here.</u>
- **57.The Poarch Creek Indian Community Scholarship** will award a minimum of one scholarship to a male and one scholarship to a female. To be eligible, you must be a resident of the State of Alabama or from the following counties in Florida:

Escambia, Santa Rosa, Okaloosa, Walton, Holmes, Washington or Gadsden. You must also have a 3.0 minimum high school GPA, shown Academic merit and community involvement, and financial need. The deadline to apply is March 15th. More info. here.

- **58.Southern Automotive Women's Forum ranges from** \$1,000-\$5,000. You must be a female high school senior or graduate enrolling in an Alabama college or university. You must also have a minimum 2.5 GPA and are pursuing a degree in a STEM or automotive field to apply. The deadline is March 12th. Read more here.
- 59. Alabama Conservation District Employees Scholarship Program gives six \$500 awards to students who are residents of the State of Alabama and planning to enter college the summer or fall of year. To be eligible, the applicant must be a U.S. Citizen, graduating high school senior, and living in the State of Alabama. The applicant should be active in student affairs and/or show leadership abilities and must show reasonable financial need. The deadline is March 4th. Apply here.
- **60.Regions Riding Forward**® **Scholarship Essay Contest** ranges from \$3,00 to \$5,000. This is for high school seniors. To be eligible, you must be a legal U.S. resident of one of the Eligible States, be age 13 or older, be enrolled in 12th grade in a public or private school (or home school) located in one of the Eligible States, have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0, and plan to attend an accredited college. The deadline for applications is March 31st. More details here.
- **61.Gray Godwin Scholarship** offers \$4,000 annually in tuition assistance to a student enrolled at Trinity Presbyterian High School. This is for current sophomores only. The deadline is March 1st. More info here.
- **62.The Mickey Ingalls Scholarship** is available to freshmen, sophomores and juniors who have completed one year at the school or will be completing his or her first year. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA in their chosen magnet discipline, submit one paragraph stating how the scholarship will be used, have the recommendation of his or her discipline director, and provide an example of his or her work to the selection committee. The award amount varies and the deadline is March 1st. Read more here.
- **63.2499** Line of Duty Scholarship awards graduating seniors of any public or private high school located in Autauga, Elmore, Lowndes, Macon or Montgomery counties. An applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and plan to attend an accredited two- or four-year college or university. An applicant should plan to pursue a career in the line of service as a first responder or a member of the military, or who is a child of any first responder or member of the military. The award amount varies and the deadline is March 1st. More info here.

- **64.Drake Cameron Scholarship** offers two scholarships open to graduating seniors from any Montgomery County high school of \$3,000 to \$5,000 will be awarded annually. There is no minimum ACT or SAT score, students must indicate by their academic performance the ability and motivation to graduate from college. Awards are based on academic achievement and need. Consideration is also given to students' leadership and participation in extracurricular activities. The deadline is March 1st. Read more here.
- **65.Dr. James H. French Memorial Scholarship** offers graduating seniors from any Pike County high school a scholarship award ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,000. The award is based on academic achievement, school and community involvement, and financial need. Applicants must have a minimum ACT score of 23 (or SAT equivalent) and a 3.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale. The deadline is March 1st. Learn more here.
- **66.Engles Family Scholarships** benefit two students annually in the amount of \$1,000 each from Montgomery who plan to attend an accredited two- or four-year college or university. The criteria requires applicants to have a minimum 3.2 GPA, minimum ACT score of 22 and community service. Consideration is given to students who have proven the ability to provide leadership or motivation to excel in school or extracurricular activities. The scholarship award will be based on demonstrated student financial need. The deadline is March 1st. More details here.
- **67.Fran Kay Schwaiger Scholarship** offers graduating seniors of any public or private high school in Cullman County two \$10,000 scholarships plus approved renewals will be awarded annually. Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, demonstrate financial need (include a copy of FAFSA), plan to attend an accredited four-year college or university, and intend to pursue a course of study in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics. The deadline is March 1st. More info here.
- **68.Jack L. Carr Scholarship** offers high school graduates pursuing a degree in engineering one \$1,500 scholarship awarded annually with determination based on academic performance and need. Recipients have the opportunity to renew the scholarship for three additional years depending upon their academic performance in college. The deadline is March 1st. <u>Learn more here.</u>

APRIL 2022

- **69.First Scholarship** is offering a \$2,000/year award. This is open to graduating seniors in high school who have participated on a FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) team or a FIRST Tech Challenge (FTC) team. Applicants must also be accepted to the University of North Alabama. Priority is given to Engineering Technology majors, but the scholarship is open to all STEM majors. The deadline to apply is April 1st. Application found here.
