Get an FSA I.D Student AND Parent Go to https://fsaid.ed.gov The student and one of the parents will need to sign up for a Federal Student Aid ID, also called an FSA ID, for us to work on the FAFSA form and sign it electronically. The website will walk you through a quick and easy login process.
